



## Uniform and equipment list September 2020

All pupils are expected to appear smart and tidy throughout the School day; uniform should be clean and suitably sized so the top button is done up and tie worn correctly (boys) and shirt tucked in. Under-clothing should not be visible or hang out outside School uniform. Girls must wear cream or white undergarments beneath their shirt.

The College believes strongly in the importance of School uniform to help create the right setting for education and School life. We ask all parents to be scrupulous in ensuring that their children return at the beginning of each term with the correct uniform, sports-kit and necessary equipment. For details regarding hair, jewellery, make-up etc - please see College Rules.

The uniform, sports kit and equipment lists which follow are subdivided into sections for:

- New boy pupils in Y9, 10 and 11
- New girl pupils in Y9, 10 and 11
- New sixth form pupils

Each section is further subdivided into items which must be purchased through:

- SchoolBlazer <https://www.Schoolblazer.com/> (Y9, 10 and 11 School uniform items; certain items for the sixth form)
- PlayerLayer <https://playerlayer.com/> (sports kit for all years)
- Other retailers (including the School Shop / café for some items); other local Shops in Eastbourne and websites. For overseas pupils, the College will provide more information on suitable Shops and websites in the Guidance for International Pupils booklet.

We insist that all items of clothing and most costly items of equipment are named to help prevent loss.

Clothing purchased from SchoolBlazer can be name-taped for a small additional charge at the time of purchase\*. Sports clothing purchased from PlayerLayer must either be name-taped at home or alternatively this can be arranged via boarding house matrons or the School Shop / café, for a charge. Name tapes (initial and surname) should be sewn in. It is suggested that name tapes are ordered online from <https://jjcash.co.uk>

All sportswear and towels should have a hanging tape for use on changing room pegs. Calculators, racquets, hockey sticks and similar items should be marked in such a way that the identification cannot be removed.

Pupils who arrive with incorrect uniform or incomplete sports kit will be asked to obtain the required items by the end of the first week of term. Pupils must take care of their belongings and replace those which are lost as soon as possible.

For parents wishing to sell **second-hand uniform**, SchoolBlazer are developing an online trade portal which should be operational by the summer of 2021. The College offers no other second hand service.

*\*It is regretted that for the summer of 2020 and for the time being thereafter, owing to Covid-19 and product handling rules, nametapes will not be sewn in to SchoolBlazer items but for customers who order them via SchoolBlazer, they will be packaged with deliveries free of charge.*

*Purchased via SchoolBlazer (or sourced independently - including School Shop) - compulsory items*

- 2 suits (double or single breasted; two or three button)  
The requirements for suits are very specific#:  
Fit - no skinny-fit trousers; skirt sufficiently generous that it does not ride up (girls)  
Length - trousers should sit on the shoe; skirt hem on the knee when standing and walking (girls)  
Style and fabric: refined, smart look. No shiny materials. Lined skirt (girls)  
Colour – dark and plain. A thin pinstripe is acceptable but a checked or flecked pattern is not; dark grey is acceptable but light grey is not; dark navy blue is acceptable but electric blue is not
- 3 white shirts (six for boarders)
- 6 pairs dark plain socks\*
- 6 pairs dark (70 denier) tights **or** six pairs dark socks **or** pop socks **or** a combination (dependent on trouser or skirt option)\*  
# If parents have any doubt over whether a non SchoolBlazer purchased suit conforms to our clothing regulations, please do not hesitate to consult the hsm or the deputy head (pastoral).

Appropriate clothing for certain formal events to which pupils may be invited, where dress code may vary from lounge suits to “black tie” (tuxedo with black bow tie)
