



## UNIFORM LIST FOR SIXTH FORM

### Uniform purchased online via SchoolBlazer

#### Compulsory items:

- 1 College overcoat\*
  - 1 Senior house tie – boys only (diagonal stripe) (2 for boarders)
- \*Pupils who purchased a College woolen dark navy overcoat between 2018-20 may continue to wear this, if it fits

#### Optional items:

- 1 College scarf (note no other scarf can be worn)

### Uniform purchased either online via SchoolBlazer, from the school shop (subject to availability), or independently sourced

#### Compulsory items:

- 2 suits (double or single breasted; 2 or 3 button) The requirements for suits are very specific:
- Fit – straight, no skinny-fit, wide leg or flared trousers (boys and girls); skirt sufficiently generous that it does not ride up (girls)
  - Length – trousers should sit on the shoe; skirt hem on the knee when standing and walking (girls)
  - Style and fabric: refined, smart look. No shiny materials. Lined skirt (girls)
  - Colour – dark and plain. A thin pinstripe is acceptable (not a thicker chalk stripe) but a checked or flecked pattern not; dark grey is acceptable but light grey is not; dark navy blue is acceptable but electric blue is not
- 3 white shirts (6 for boarders)
- 6 pairs dark plain socks\*

6 pairs dark (70 denier, 40 in summer) tights or 6 pairs dark socks or pop socks or a combination (dependent on trouser or skirt option)\*

Appropriate clothing for certain formal events to which pupils may be invited, where dress code may vary from lounge suits to “black tie” (tuxedo with black bow tie)

If parents have any doubt over whether a non SchoolBlazer purchased suit conforms to our clothing regulations, please do not hesitate to consult the HSM or the Deputy Head (Pastoral).

#### Optional items:

1-2 V-necked sweater (monochrome, plain, non-cable-knit, colour in-keeping with College image)

### Uniform not purchased from SchoolBlazer

#### Compulsory:

1 pair plain black polishable shoes, (of formal style in keeping with image of College (eg not black trainers))  
Decoration may only comprise plain brogue leather and / or a discrete buckle) girls heels less than 1.5 inches

### Uniform purchased in school shop

#### Compulsory:

1 ID card holder and house lanyard

## Sports kit purchased online via PlayerLayer

### Compulsory:

- 1 House shirt
- 1 House socks
- 1 College Ocean WeatherLayer Jacket
- 1 College quarter zip mid-layer top
- 1 College tracksuit/trainalayer bottoms
- 1 Navy Skort or Navy Blitz Field Shorts
- 1 White College shirt - polo
- 1 Red College shirt - t-shirt
- 1 Navy College shirt - polo
  - 2 College long socks (navy and red)

### Optional items (but recommended for certain sports and outdoor sports):

- 3 pairs white socks
- 1 College insulated / puffa layer
- 1-2 Eco-Leggings (note – these can be worn for activities but not as a tracksuit bottom around campus, in dining hall, classrooms, town leave etc)
- 1 College Reversalayer jersey/rugby top
- 1 Navy Blitz rugby short (1st XV only)
- 1 White Blitz Field short (summer term only – tennis)
- 1 College cricket shirt
- 1 College cricket trousers
- 1 Netball dress – Lent term, fitting and ordering take place in September
- 1 Football Shirt

### Other sports items required:

- 1 gum shield (school can organise OPRO fitted ones in September; shop also stocks boil-fit type) for hockey and rugby players
- 1 pair College shin pads (for hockey players -school shop can supply)
- 1 holdall-type bag (can be purchased online via PlayerLayer or sourced elsewhere)
- 1 pair non-marking indoor sports shoes (preferably white)
- 1 pair training / running shoes (composite

off /on-road type)

- 1 pair astro-turf shoes recommended for senior team hockey players (girls in Michaelmas term; boys in Lent)
- 1 hockey stick (girl hockey players for Michaelmas term; boys in Lent) (Schoolshop can supply)

More information will be provided regarding other specialist sports equipment.

### All pupils also require:

- 1 Laptop or similar keyboard-enabled device (Apple Macbook or Windows PC both fine; pupils coming from College Year 11 will already have an iPad)\*
- 1 College ID card (issued on arrival - £5 charge for loss)
- 1 black fountain pen (recommended) 3-4 black biros / rollerball pens
- 2 coloured biros
- 2 highlighter pens
- 1 calculator FX – 991EX – for science, economics, geography etc A-level
- 1 ruler
- 1 protractor
- 2-3 HB pencils
- 1 eraser
- 1 Water bottle (multi-use) for trips and day-to-day (School Shop sells branded metal ones; only fully transparent ones with no writing can be used in exams)

Paper, files and other stationery must be supplied by sixth form pupils themselves

**Boarding pupils also require:**

- 1 Duvet (not feather)
- 2 Duvet covers (sheets and pillowcases are provided by the College but most pupils prefer to bring their own duvet covers (College can provide if not))
- 4 Bath towels marked at corner
- 1 Dressing gown
- 3 Sets pyjamas
- 1 Pair of slippers / sliders (not to be worn outside)
- 1 Washbag
- 1 Overnight case or bag
- 1 Shoe-cleaning kit
- 1 Tuck box, lockable (optional, but lockable space recommended)

Home clothes for casual wear and some visits away from College. Attire on such occasions must be sensible, practical and suitable (no skimpy shorts, dresses, cut-away or cropped t-shirts, baseball caps, and so on)
